Property asking prices stalled in April, according to a new report, which says baby boomers trying to 'downsize' are now the driving force in the housing market

The already top-heavy property market is becoming increasingly skewed towards cash-rich homeowners, with trading down from a large family house now the single biggest reason given for selling by homeowners approaching estate agents, says property website Rightmove.

Some 40 per cent of sellers say they are looking to trade down, compared with 25 per cent who hope to trade up to a larger more expensive property.






